

**CST104 Special Studies in Christian Ministries:  
Foundations for Lasting Relationships

**Course Description**

A specific study of 12 relationship principles focused on the purpose of increasing one's ability to create and maintain lasting relationships. The information in this course will lead students to make paradigm shifts from humanistic beliefs and behavior to a biblical foundation regarding all human relationships. This course will inspire students to lead by example their generation through lasting relationship goals and lifestyles.

**Learning Goals**

As a result of the study conducted in this course, it is anticipated that each student will:

1. Demonstrate understanding of each principle and its biblical context
2. Demonstrate an ability to discuss the principles in small groups and during class dialogue
3. Distinguish between a biblical worldview of relationships and prevailing western worldviews of relationships
4. Understand and apply the (12) principles of relationships to their present personal relationships and develop a theoretical framework for all future significant relationships
