


Worship is something we do

"Worship is communion with God in which believers, by grace, center their mind's attention and heart's affection on the Lord, humbly glorifying Him in response to His greatness and His Word."



WORSHIP IS CENTERED ON CHRIST

Colossians 1:15-20

Philippians 2:5-11



COLOSSIANS 1:15-20

He is the **image** of the invisible God, the **firstborn** of all creation.

For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him.

And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together.

And he is the **head of the body**, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be preeminent.

For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross.




PHILIPPIANS 2:5-11

Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though **he was in the form of God**, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but **emptied himself**, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men.

And being found in human form, **he humbled himself** by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

Therefore **God has highly exalted him** and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus **every knee should bow**, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and **every tongue confess** that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the **glory of God the Father.**



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



WORSHIP IS CORPORATE IN NATURE
