For your first semester at CBU:

Provisional students may register up to 13 units.

Standard students may register up to 16 units (15 units for transfer students).

Honors students may register up to 18 units.

Students who complete prerequisites by December 31 (fall) may apply for the following fall start.

Students who complete prerequisites by April 30 (spring) may apply for the following fall start.

Students who complete prerequisites by August 31 (summer) may apply for the following spring start.
